TIME/DATE OF SITUATION REPORT: 15:15 PM August 4, 2006

TIME/DATE OF THE NEXT REPORT: As the situation warrants.

TYPE/AMOUNT OF PRODUCT SPILLED: The reporting party stated the vessel had 500 gallons of diesel fuel and 10 drums of gasoline on board when the vessel sank. The amount of product spilled is unknown at this time. A one mile long sheen is reported coming from the vessel.

LOCATION: The vessel is reported to have sunk just south of Narrow Point on Prince of Wales Island in Clarence Strait. The location of the sinking is approximately 38 nautical miles northwest of Ketchikan, Alaska

CAUSE OF SPILL: The 40 foot wooden fishing vessel is reported to have grounded and sunk.

POTENTIAL RESPONSIBLE PARTY (PRP): The PRP is Jim Widmyer of Edna Bay, Prince of Wales Island.

RESPONSE ACTION: The PRP will attempt to remove the drums of gasoline. The Coast Guard and a DEC representative will travel to the scene by aircraft to access the situation. The Coast Guard has requested opening the National Pollution Response Fund and may hire a cleanup contractor if required.

SOURCE CONTROL: None at this time.

RESOURCES AFFECTED: The marine waters of Clarence Strait. There is no report of injuries to wildlife or other resources.

FUTURE PLANS AND RECOMMENDATIONS: ADEC and Coast Guard personnel will conduct an overflight of the scene this afternoon weather permitting. The owner of the vessel will attempt to remove the drums of gasoline. The US Forest Service reports a recreational beach is located in the area and is sending local personnel to determine if the area has been impacted by the spill. Additional actions will be determined after the overflight of the vessel.

WEATHER: S.E. Winds at 15 kts with 5 foot seas in rain. The seas are projected to reduce to 3 feet for tonight and tomorrow with the winds unchanged.
