TIME/DATE OF SPILL: 1:15 PM, October 15, 2007. BPXA reported the spill to ADEC at 1:57 PM on October 15, 2007.

TIME/DATE OF SITUATION REPORT: 1:00 PM December 3, 2007.

TIME/DATE OF THE NEXT REPORT: This is the final report

<u>TYPE/AMOUNT OF PRODUCT SPILLED</u>: BPXA has estimated the spill volume total at 1,932 gallons (46 bbls) of product. Included in this total is 630 gallons (15 bbls) of neat methanol, 1260 gallons (30 bbls) of a 60/40 methanol water mixture and 42 gallons (1 bbl) of a crude / water mixture. Neat methanol is 100 % methanol.

LOCATION: Flow Station 2, Prudhoe Bay Oil Field, Deadhorse, Alaska.

<u>CAUSE OF SPILL</u>: The flowline was punctured when it moved with sufficient force to strike an adjacent horizontal support module and penetrated the pipe wall.

POTENTIAL RESPONSIBLE PARTY (PRP): BPXA.

<u>RESPONSE ACTION</u>: Initial response actions were limited to the removal of the contaminated water on top of the pond ice and the areas adjacent to the pipe rack due to the source control work being done on the pipe that had ruptured. Following the installation of the patch over the rupture site the ACS responders flushed the area with hot water to melt the contaminated ice and snow. Vacuum trucks were then used to remove the contaminated water from the spill site.

After the contaminated water had been removed, the spill site was sampled to verify that that all of the contaminated material had been removed. Several areas were identified that needed additional cleanup work. The spot cleanup is expected to be completed by the end of the first week of December and those areas re-sampled.

As of today BPXA has reported that 1,427,580 gallons (33,990 bbls) of contaminated water have been removed from the spill site.

SOURCE CONTROL: Full source control was achieved at 10:30 PM on October 18, 2007 when a clamp was bolted in place over the pipeline rupture. No additional leakage has been observed.

RESOURCES AFFECTED: Tundra pond, tundra and adjacent gravel pad. BPXA estimates that the total area impacted is about 0.731 acres.

<u>FUTURE PLANS AND RECOMMENDATIONS</u> Complete the spot cleanup and resample those areas of the spill site.

WEATHER: Partly Cloudy, blowing snow, temperature 10 to 15 degrees F.
